6. **Toothpaste (travel size)**
7. **Shampoo & conditioner (travel size)**
8. **Body lotion (travel size)**
9. Reusable tote bags/lightweight backpacks (used ok)
10. Foot powder
11. Razors
12. Lip balm/Chapstick
13. Small disposable medicine dosing cups

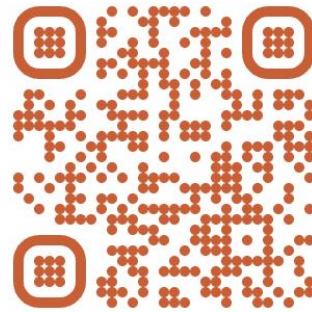
