To be eligible for the Ronnie Parks Scholarship a student must:

- Be a senior student graduating from any high school in the Ysleta Independent School District during the award year, and have met all graduation requirements as set forth by the Ysleta Independent School District and the State of Texas by June 2019.
- Have a cumulative GPA of 80 or above.
- Have been accepted for enrollment by an accredited two-year college or university majoring in Fine Arts. The Fine Arts requirement could consist of Theatre Arts, Film Production, Music, Art or Dance.

- 2. Three (3) letters of recommendation: One letter should be from an individual who has been instrumental in inspiring you to follow the path you want to follow. This could be a teacher (either private or public) who can speak to your talent and drive. The other letters can be from high school administrators, faculty, staff, community members, employers, personal friends, or clergy who are familiar with your ability work habits, integrity, and potential.
- 3. List of Accomplishments: Provide a list of awards, honors, extra-curricular activities, and other significant accomplishments.
- 4. Official high school transcript.
